*Psalm 119:103 How sweet are your words to my taste, sweeter than honey to my mouth!*

*The psalmist used the sweetness of honey to describe the sweetness of God's words. He described it as sweeter than honey - something so sweet that he cannot describe it. It enlightens our souls and spirits.*

*One keyword in this verse is "my." Are you treasuring God's words and finding His words very sweet? It is only when you continuously read God's words and meditate on them that you will find them sweet.*

*The chapter of Psalm 119 is about God's words. Verses 97 to 104 are about loving God's words. Besides knowing and meditating on God's words, we need to obey them. Verse 102 states, "I have not departed from your laws, for you yourself have taught me." When you find something sweet and wonderful, would you let it go? We do not "let go" of God's words in our daily lives but live according to the teachings.*

*The concluding verse is verse 104. It states, "I gain understanding from your precepts; therefore, I hate every wrong path." God's words teach righteousness, give wisdom, and provide hope and comfort. It also reminds us not to sin.*
