TAKE UP YOUR CROSS AND FOLLOW JESUS



To deny oneself & take up the cross — That is one of the criteria to be His disciple. Self-denial is not just having some inconvenience, but it demands major sacrifices. We need to give up our former desires and the old way of life.

To follow Jesus — This is a call for full commitment to Christ's way. How can you follow Jesus unless you are very close to Him. Thus, seek Him and act according to His way daily. Jesus already set the example. He humbles Himself to God and took on the cross. He follows God's will.

Matthew 16:24 Then Jesus said to his disciples, "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me."
