INVITATION TO THE KING'S BANQUET

Nobody can easily see a king. The palace is often isolated from the public. It is often a long path from the palace entrance to the place where the king resides. One needs an invitation to see a King. Only special persons can get an invitation to a king's banquet.

However, God (the king of kings) invites all of us to His banquet. It is stated in Matthew chapter 22, Revelation 19:9 & 3:20.

Two aspects of this invitation:

The servant – All of us who belong to God's family are the servants in this case. We need to invite all nonbelievers to attend God's banquet. Are you diligent in your role? Have you gone out to gather all the people you can find? Can you see the joy when the banquet is filled with people?

Matthew 22:9-10 So go to the street corners and invite to the banquet anyone you find. So the servants went out into the streets and gathered all the people they could find, the bad as well as the good, and the wedding hall was filled with guests.
