



Rev. 22:5 There will be no more night. They will not need the light of a lamp or the light of the sun, for the Lord God will give them light. And they will reign forever and ever.

This Bible passage is about the restored Garden of Eden (new Heaven and Earth). Eden is a beautiful place. The beautiful scene in the photo cannot be compared to the restored Eden. Even the light from the sun cannot be compared. This is the promise of God. There are three applications of this verse that can help us today:

- 1. The first sentence is about no more physical darkness. It means we are no longer constrained by physical matters. We will be out of this dark and sinful world if we apply this verse spiritually. There is so much sin in this world. Sin does not exist when we are with God at that time.*
 - 2. The phrase Lord God will give them light. Any light on earth cannot be compared to the light from God. This verse also has spiritual implications. We know we are not perfect now. At that time, we will receive God's spiritual light directly. God will communicate with us and lead us. God and His people have intimate communion.*
 - 3. We will reign with Christ forever and ever. With supportive verses such as II Tim. 2:12 and Rom. 8:17, we share His sufferings now but will share His glory in the future.*
- Let this promise dwell in our heart. It can strengthen us to face this dark world every day.*
